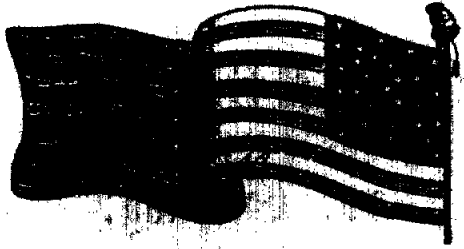

THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA,

To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting:

WHEREAS, In pursuance of the Act of Congress, approved March 3, 1855, entitled "An Act in addition to certain Acts granting Bounty Land to certain Officers and Soldiers who have been engaged in the military service of the United States," there has been deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE, Warrant No. 2435 for 100 acres, in favor of

with evidence that the same has been duly located upon the East half of the Northwest quarter, and the East half of the Southwest quarter of section eight in township thirty North of Range fifteen West, in the district of lands subject to sale at Prussia City Michigan, containing one hundred and sixty acres

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of said Lands returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the SURVEYOR GENERAL the said warrant having been assigned by Aaron Gilmore, son and only heir at law of the said Cynthia Gilmore, deceased, to Edwin H. Munger, in whose favor said tract has been located.

NOW KNOW YE, That there is therefore granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said Edwin H. Munger as assignee as aforesaid and to his heirs

the tract of Land above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said Edwin H. Munger as assignee as aforesaid and to his

heirs and assigns forever.
