To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting:

WHEREAS, In pursuance of the Act of Congress, approved March 3, 1855, entitled an "An Act in addition to certain Acts granting Bounty Land to certain Officers and Soldiers who have been engaged in the military service of the United States," there has been deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE, Warrant No. 86,971 for 120 acres, in favor of Franklin Field, Private, Captain Phillips' Company, New York Militia New York Frontier Disturbances

with evidence that the same has been duly located upon the fractional Section, twenty six, and the lot, numbered one, of Section twenty seven, and the lot, numbered four and the north west quarter, of the north west quarter, of Section, thirty five, in Township Thirty one, north of Range fifteen west, in the district of lands subject to sale, at Traverse City, Michigan, containing one hundred and twenty five acres, and thirty hundredths, of an acre

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of said Lands returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the SURVEYOR GENERAL the said Warrant, having been assigned by the said Franklin Field, to Putnam Burdick, in whose favor said tract, has been located

NOW KNOW YE, That there is therefore granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said Putnam Burdick, as assignee, as aforesaid, and to his heirs

the tract of Land above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said Putnam Burdick, as assignee, as aforesaid, and to his

heirs and assigns forever.

In testimony whereof, I, Abraham Lincoln, PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, have caused these Letters to be made Patent, and the SEAL OF THE GENERAL LAND OFFICE to be hereunto affixed.
