

- SHELTER, JOHN A.**—Age, 20 years. Enlisted, January 2, 1864, at Stuyvesant; private, unassigned, to serve three years; borne only on muster and descriptive roll with line through name.
- SHEPPARD, BYRON H.**—Age, 19 years. Enlisted, January 1, 1864, at Middlesex; mustered in as private, unassigned, January 4, 1864, to serve three years; assigned to Co. K, date not stated; died of disease and wounds, November 22, 1864, at United States General Hospital, Fort Monroe, Va.; also borne as Shepard and Shephard.
- SHEPPARD, MORRIS F.**—Age, 20 years. Enrolled, January 8, 1864, at Albany; mustered in as first lieutenant, Co. D, to date, December 7, 1863, to serve three years; captain, Co. G, March 4, 1864; mustered out with company, August 21, 1865, at Washington, D. C.; commissioned first lieutenant, January 7, 1864, with rank from December 7, 1863; original; captain, March 23, 1864, with rank from March 4, 1864, vice J. C. Hicks, discharged; also borne as Morris T.
- SHERIDAN, WILLIAM E.**—Age, 44 years. Enlisted, August 8, 1863, at Albion, for Thirty-fifth Battery, to serve three years; transferred to and mustered in as private, Co. A, this regiment, September 28, 1863; discharged for disability, December 15, 1864, at Willett's Point, New York Harbor.
- SHERMAN, CHARLES.**—Age, 35 years. Enlisted, January 1, 1864, at Auburn; mustered in as private, Co. L, January 26, 1864, to serve three years; mustered out with company, August 21, 1865, at Washington, D. C.
- SHERMAN, E. B.**—Age, 31 years. Enlisted, September 22, 1863, at Rome; mustered in as private, unassigned, September 23, 1863, to serve three years; no further record.
- SHERMAN, EDGAR.**—Age, 41 years. Enlisted, January 4, 1864, at Otsego; mustered in as private, Co. A, January 4, 1864, to serve three years; mustered out with company, August 21, 1865, at Washington, D. C.; veteran.
- SHERMAN, JOHN.**—Age, 18 years. Enlisted, October 31, 1863, at Auburn; mustered in as private, Co. D, December 7, 1863, to serve three years; mustered out with company, August 21, 1865, at Washington, D. C.
