Wherein the Right Honorable Presidents shall come, etc.

WHEREAS, In pursuance of the Act of Congress, approved March 3, 1855, entitled an "An Act in addition to certain Acts granting Bounty Land to certain Officers and Soldiers who have been engaged in the military service of the United States," there has been deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE, Warrant No. 363 for 160 acres, in favor of Hetty Gallender, widow of Thomas L. Gallender, private, Captain Murray's company, New York Militia, War 1812.

with evidence that the same has been duly located upon The Lots numbered one, two, and three, of Section ten, in Township Thirty-one North, of Range fourteen West, in the District of Lands subject to Sale at Traverse City, Michigan, containing one hundred and seventy-eight acres and eighty hundredths of an acre.

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of said Lands returned to the **GENERAL LAND OFFICE** by the SURVEYOR GENERAL the said warrant having been assigned by Hetty J. Bulkley, sole Administratrix and devisee of the said Hetty Gallender, deceased, to Edwin H. Felt, and by him to Edwin R. Munger, in whose favor said tract has been located.

NOW KNOW YE, That there is therefore granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said Edwin R. Munger as assignee as aforesaid and to his heirs

the tract of Land above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said Edwin R. Munger as assignee as aforesaid and to his

heirs and assigns forever.
