according to the Official Plat of the Survey of said Lands returned to the allegand Land Office by the SURVEYOR GENERAL the Said Warrant having been assigned by the Said Benjamin me Kinney to Nicholar Richard, in whose favor land tract has been becauted.

NOW KNOW YE, That there is therefore granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said Nichlas Sickard, as assigned as aforesaid and to his him,

the tract of Land above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said Nicholas Nickard, as assigned, as aforesaid land to his.

heirs and assigns forever.
