

To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting:

Act in addition to certain Acts granting Bounty Land to certain Officers and Soldiers who have been engaged in the military service of the United States," there has been deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE, Warrant No. 100, 754 for 160 acres, in favor of Julian Martines, Teamster, W. S. Quarter Masters Department, Mar with Nexico,

with evidence that the same has been duly located upon the South Cast quarter of Section five, in Township thirty, of Range fifteen Mest, in the District of lands subject to Sale at Snaverse City, Michigan, containing one hundred and sixty acres,

the SURVEYOR GENERAL, the said warrant having been assigned by the Said fulian Martinez to Perham Burdick, in whose fator said bruch last been located.

NOW KNOW YE, That there is therefore granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said Jutnam Bendisk, as assigned as aforesaid, and to his heirs,

the tract of Land above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land, with the appartenances thereof, unto the said Putnam Burdick, as afigured as aforesaid, and to his

heirs and assigns forever.
